SCHOOL PREFECTS

- They have listened to this year's prefects outline the roles and responsibilities of a prefect and what is involved.
- If they wish to be nominated they need to fill out the form below and return it to their class teacher before **Wednesday 25 October**.

- These students elected by their peers will be allowed to begin their campaign on Thursday 2 November;
 1. By placing up **2** posters (they are responsible for putting up in the morning and taking down in the afternoon).
 2. They will also have to work on preparing a 2 minute speech which they will give to the school during week 6 (Monday 13 November).

No badges, bracelets, lollies etc are to be handed out by candidates during the campaign.
