Principal's Message

EXTERNAL VALIDATION

All NSW public schools now have to go through an external validation process once every 5 years. We are currently preparing our documentation with our validation panel meeting scheduled for Tuesday 5 September.

I see this as an opportunity to celebrate all that is great about our school and the journey we have been on. We are validated against the School Excellence Framework, which covers three domains: Learning, Teaching and Leading.

We look forward to sharing the outcome of our validation process in the coming weeks.

Book Fair

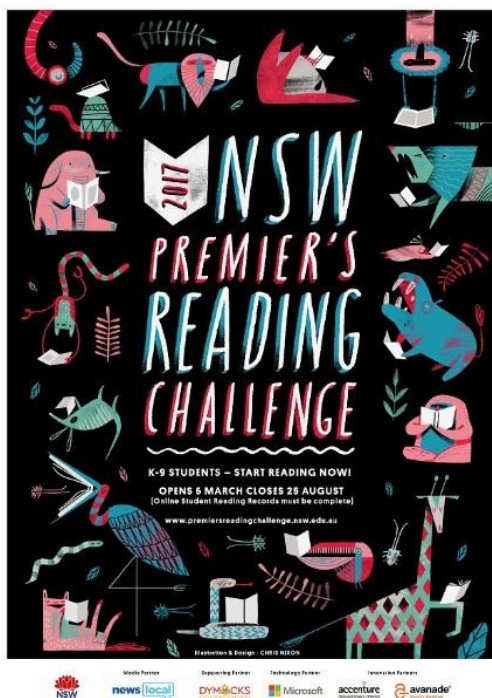
