

Students in 2W have been learning about onomatopoeia and today they worked with a friend to create their own poems using words such as 'bang, pop and splash! They are fabulous little poets!




Highlights continued


Thank you also to **KARI** for supporting our Aboriginal students in their transition to high school. The backpacks provided are beautifully designed by the amazing artist **DJMate**.
